Throughout these meetings, we have seen the Lord do the miraculous in allowing another 13% of our support to be raised these past two months. Ultimately the credit goes to the Lord, but I recognize the fact that it is the Lord using a tremendous amount of people who are faithful to Him through their local church. I realize God has given us an amazing support group and we thank Him for you all constantly. This increase brings our total support level to 70% and is allowing more excitement as we get closer to our goal of leaving for language school next May.
